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Nice looking car. Don't want to nit-pick it, but a few observations:

1. Hard to tell from picture, but the brushed aluminum lower body cladding could be from a Bonneville. I know of no factory option to add that to a Cat.
2. I'm more curious as to what that thing is to the left of the A/C vent in the dash. Doesn't look like an after-market add-on.
3. incorrect upholstery pattern
4. he claims 356hp. If so, the intake is incorrect - should be Tri-Power. Probably was originally a 338hp 4-BBL.
5. I'm hoping that no holes were drilled in the dash to mount the 2+2 and star emblems.
