Hi, I'm new to this site. I would like to let you know that we have had our 2+2 in the family since new. My father bought the car on Thursday after I beat him on Sunday, on the street. The story is pretty interesting, at that time my dad (a Pontiac lover from way back) was driving his '62 Bonneville convert. and I was driving my '63 Stingray. Although my father's car was equipped with the 389 Tri-Power, my 340 hp just plain got the best of him. After the race, the following Thursday, we went to the local Pontiac dealer (Householder's) and ordered the 2+2 that we have now. The car is a real eye catcher whenever I drive it (probably because it's so long). The color is Maize yellow, with a black top (convert) and black interior, 8-lug wheels, power brakes, reverb radio and no power steering. When asked if he wanted to order power steering he asked "how much horsepower would it take?" He was told 6-8 hp, his response was "###44kki the power steering" and that's how the car was ordered. My father passed away a few years ago and I still get the Poncho out in the summertime. It's a blast since it does have the HO engine with trips. I did get to race the car at the local drag strip (running D Pure Stock) running against other Pontiacs and Mopar 383 High Po's . I did manage 4 trophies out of 5 attempts.
